

below the surface The entombed artifacts lay undisturbed until 2003 A circuitous path brought thirteen of the original thirty seven Clovis bifaces and points through many hands before reachi Waters and Jennings provide a valuable contribution to the study of Clovis archaeology lithic technology and individual cache assemblages Their work stands as an excellent model for reporting these relatively rare finds If only all Clovis caches were
